



To protect our staff, patients, and community during the outbreak of COVID-19, visitor restrictions are in place.

Routine visiting is suspended at Sparrow Hospital until the transmission of COVID-19 is no longer a threat to our patients, staff and community.

All of our obstetric patients may have **one** support person with them. This support person must pass the screening at hospital entry and have no symptoms of illness.

**As the support person:**

You are encouraged to stay with the patient in the room for the entire admission.

You will use the patient bathroom and shower. Pack a bag with your toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, clothes, and whatever else you may want for a 2-3 day stay.

Sparrow will provide you with 3 meals per day. Meals are ordered by phone from the room and will be delivered to you. A nurse will provide you with a menu.

You may bring your own snacks or food if desired. The food must stay in the room. We cannot store it or heat it. The labor and postpartum rooms do not have refrigerators.

Water and coffee can be requested at any time. Please ask your nurse.
