



## **COVID-19 and Pregnancy**

At Alliance we are committed to your care and safety during the Covid-19 Pandemic. Information regarding pregnancy and risk continues to change.

As of June 24, 2020, the current belief is that the overall risk during pregnancy remains low. It is possible that women who are pregnant and have severe illness may be more likely to require ICU admission and use of mechanical ventilation. We do not believe that being pregnant will increase your rates of death from Covid-19.

We recommend for you to continue to follow the recommended precautions from the CDC to limit exposure to Covid-19. If you have concerns about your potential level of risk due to your job, we encourage you to discuss these concerns with your physician or midwife at your next appointment. Most pregnant women will be able to continue to work.

If you are pregnant and have been diagnosed with Covid, please consider contacting the PRIORITY: Pregnancy Coronavirus Outcomes Registry. This registry will help to increase the medical community's knowledge of how Covid-19 effects pregnancy.
