



Sparrow Visitor Policy

In Labor and Delivery (L&D) and Mother Baby Center (MBC), patients are permitted two visitors/support persons at bedside at a time. A certified Doula does not count towards a support person. There is a small waiting room outside of OB Triage.

In OB Triage, patients are permitted to have one support person.

Sparrow Visitor policy is as follows:

- Labor & Delivery and Triage do not have restricted hours for visitation.
- Mother Baby Center allows support persons from 8am to 8pm. Dedicated patient rest time is 1pm to 3pm. Visiting is discouraged during this time. **Only one person over the age of 18 can stay the night.**
- All patients and visitors will be required to wear a mask. Cloth masks are not allowed. Visitors may wear their own N95 mask, or surgical masks are provided at the entrance of the hospital.
- Visitors must have a patient specific security code to enter both Labor & Delivery and Mother Baby Center.
- Visitors must be 12 years old or older.
- Visitors 12 – 17 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
- Social distancing standards must be observed during your visit.
- Covid testing is only needed when symptomatic.
